

Dear Mark Belling,

Thank you for your comments on the radio the other day concerning Judge Dennis Flynn. I was glad to hear someone who had the courage to speak out against him because my own experience agrees with what you said. I know from experience that Judge Flynn has been involved in racketeering. He cost me personally \$200k because of fraud and this has had a very negative impact on my family, my business, and my life. He cost Michael Dillworth \$250k through his dishonesty. Along with Theodore Dremel, the man involved in nursing home fraud by neglecting the elderly at Westview Nursing Home in 1987. Flynn's dishonesty was the cause of Rudolph's Grocery Store having to close it's doors. As you can see, his activities have caused real hurt to real people and to small businesses.

Land Use Attorney, Michael Best, of Milwaukee told me that Dennis Flynn was influenced by Theodore Dremel to keep Michael Dillworth's subdivision out of Dover and later put in Deer Meadows for Ted Dremel

Michael Dillworth was to develop the Eagle View subdivision.

Because of Flynn, there has been continual racketeering in the courtroom of Racine, WI Certainly he engaged in racketeering spanning 93 - 99 with Thomas Lembke as an accessory..

Other people associated with Flynn's racketeering included Matt McVey.(deceased) Arnold Clement (retired, zoning) and Ed Furey.

The worst of it is that this is getting stronger every day and no one will investigate Bill McReynolds, a crooked Sheriff, stopped a criminal investigation in 1999. In 2004, when he was reminded of how he obstructed justice involving Dennis Flynn, he had a heart attack in Kansasville's oldest truck repair garage.

Dennis Flynn's racketeering was reported by the high profile criminal attorney in Racine, Michael Piontek, yet despite this - and after 18 years and three sheriffs - we still can't get an investigation into the Town of Dover.

Would you be willing to try and start an investigation into corruption in the Town of Dover?
