Thank you for your recent inquiry regarding the status of this matter.

Many of the specific complaints which you referred to us and which we discussed at our meeting last August are simply too old for us to pursue. Even if an investigation of these complaints turned up evidence of criminal wrongdoing, it would be too late to prosecute anyone for them. Therefore, we cannot justify allocating resources to investigate matters about which we could not take any action.

However, we have decided to look into the apparent practice of the town to pass along the costs of hiring engineering services to individual residents. We have requested and obtained from the town documents that pertain to this practice. We are currently reviewing those materials.
